

Bags and aprons made of 100 % cotton woven fabric in natural/raw white, bleached white, reactive dyed and pigment printed as well as 100 % jute woven fabric in natural/raw white, pigment printed, with or without polypropylene lamination, including accessories (sewing threads, zippers and printed labels); produced by using materials certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®.

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by 0EK0-TEX®, Annex 4, product class II have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by 0EK0-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
